

Oct 21st RULES

High points for each class will be awarded according to the number of entries in each class. First place will win points equal to number of entries plus 1. For example: If there are 5 entries in a class, 1st place will win 6 points, 2nd place 5 points, 3rd 4 points, etc. , with every contestant who enters getting one point unless DQ'd, no-time, broken pattern, etc.

We strongly suggest all minor contestants wear helmets in all running and cattle classes.

Western Trail Pleasure – gaited horse – western tack and attire, must neck rein horses over 4 yr old in curb bit, 2 hands allowed on rein only in snaffle or bosal, back in line-up, 3-gait- walk, show gait (rack, running walk, fox trot, single-foot, etc.), and canter, flat-shod or barefoot, no boots, chains, or action devices.

Country Trail Pleasure – gaited horse– english or western tack and attire, 2-gait- walk, show gait (rack, running walk, fox trot, single-foot, etc.), flat-shod or barefoot, no boots, chains, or action devices.

Western Pleasure and Westernn Walk-Trot- proper western tack and attire required

English Walk-Trot and HUS classes- proper hunt seat tack and attire required

Youth team penning- No trash in pen, 1 trash allowed over the line. Trash must be run back across foul line before calling for time.

Junior and Pee Wee team penning- No trash in pen, 1 trash allowed over the line.

Youth and Junior one-on-one penning- No trash allowed in pen

Pee Wee one-on-one. Pen one cow- any number.

2-man sorting- arena divided in middle with panels with an opening in the middle. Cattle are sorted in numerical order. If a cow crosses into the other side out of order, or if a sorted cow crosses back through the opening, you will get a no-time.

Hats are not required in cattle or timed event classes (we suggest you wear a riding helmet), but *if you wear one and it comes off in the arena you will be assessed a 5 second penalty.*

No dogs and **no alcohol** allowed on the premises

You may enter timed classes only one time on same horse. You may enter more than one horse, and different riders can enter on same horse.

You may enter team penning and sorting more than once as long as at least one partner is different for each team, or you change horses. You can only enter one-on-one penning one time on same horse, but as many times as you wish on different horses.
